Code of Ethics for Members, Coaches, and Officials

- I will respect the individuality of every child, youth, and adult and support their development. I will respect the individual feelings regarding closeness and distance, the privacy, and the personal boundaries of modesty of the children, youths, and adults entrusted to my care, as well as those of other club members.
- I will guide children, adolescents, and adults in their personal development toward appropriate social behavior toward others. I will teach them to behave fairly and respectfully toward people and animals both within and outside of sports activities, and I will guide them to treat nature and the environment responsibly.
- I will always tailor sports and non-sports activities to the developmental level of the children, adolescents, and adults entrusted to my care and use appropriate methods accordingly.
- I will always strive to create fair conditions for the children, adolescents, and adults entrusted to my care in both sports and non-sports activities.
- I will respect the rights of children, adolescents, and adults entrusted to my care to physical integrity and will not engage in any form of violence, whether physical, psychological, emotional, or sexual in nature.
- I will ensure that the rules of the respective dance sport disciplines are followed. In particular, I will serve as a positive and active role model in the fight against doping and medication abuse, as well as against any form of performance manipulation.
- I will offer the children, adolescents, and adults entrusted to my care sufficient opportunities for self-determination and participation in all sports and non-sports activities.
- I respect the dignity of every child, adolescent, and adult, and I promise to treat all people equally and fairly, regardless of their social, ethnic, or cultural background, worldview, religion, political beliefs, sexual orientation, age, or gender, and to resolutely oppose discrimination of any kind as well as anti-democratic ideologies.
- I want to be a role model for the children, adolescents, and adults entrusted to my care, always instilling a commitment to following the rules of sports and interpersonal conduct, and acting in accordance with the principles of fair play.
- I commit to intervening if this Code of Ethics is violated in my environment. In the event of a "conflict," I will seek professional support and assistance and inform the responsible parties at the management level and/or the contact persons listed on the DTV and state associations' websites. The protection of children, adolescents, and adults is my top priority.
