Press Guidelines

Responsibility of Photographers and Videographers for Complying with Child and Youth Protection Laws and Privacy Rights

Photographers and videographers have a significant influence on how the public perceives competitive dance. This entails a special responsibility toward athletes, particularly—but not exclusively—those in the children's and youth categories.

The following points are therefore non-negotiable principles to which accreditation for tournaments organized by the Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. is subject; failure to comply with them may result in the revocation of accreditation (including the refusal to reissue it in the future) and may even lead to exclusion from the current and all future events:

- Dance sport must be portrayed positively in the images captured; unflattering images will not be published.
- To best protect personal rights, no photos or videos will be taken of individuals in obviously private situations, or when they are clearly experiencing negative emotions or are in conflict situations.
- Even in public situations, the person photographed has the right to have the image deleted.
- No sexually suggestive or erotic scenes will be photographed. So-called “upskirting” and “downblousing” are prohibited.
- To prevent the risk of involuntary upskirting, no photos or videos will be taken at any tournaments from positions where the camera lens is positioned below the standard table edge. This rule applies to all age groups and skill levels.
- You have accepted in writing the provisions of the Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. accreditation guidelines, and they apply to all assignments.
- Before publishing images and videos online, they must be reviewed again in advance to ensure compliance with the points listed above.

As an accredited photographer and/or videographer, you are an official part of the event and are therefore obligated to intervene in the event of violations of personal rights (including those beyond the points mentioned above) or interpersonal violence (in particular, but not exclusively, of a sexual or racist nature) committed by third parties, and/or to report such incidents to the responsible persons on site.

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Legal Notice for Photographers

Revocation of the Photography License in the Event of Discrediting

The Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. reserves the right to revoke the photography license granted for the accreditation of photographers at any time if individuals—in particular children and adolescents, who are especially vulnerable—are discredited or portrayed in an inappropriate manner through the photographs taken, their reproduction, publication, resale, or other use—are discredited in terms of their dignity, reputation, or personal and social environment, or are portrayed in an inappropriate manner.

The photographer agrees to immediately cease the use and distribution of the affected images upon request by the Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. and, to the extent technically and legally possible, to withdraw any images that have already been published. From the time the photo license is revoked, any further publication or other use of the photographs in question is expressly prohibited.

Should the photographer fail to comply with this instruction or otherwise fail to address the grounds for revocation, the Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. reserves the right to assert claims for damages. This includes, in particular, legal action taken to enforce the interests of the Grün-Gold-Club Bremen e.V. and to protect the individuals concerned. Such action may include initiating warning procedures, applying for preliminary injunctions, or filing a lawsuit seeking an injunction and claiming damages to the full extent permitted by law. All legal costs and expenses arising from the enforcement of these protective measures may be billed to the photographer in accordance with applicable law.
